ECPI's statement following RAC's opinion on DINP and DIDP restrictions in toys

On 5-8 March, the Risk Assessment Committee (RAC) of the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) adopted an Opinion on the ECHA Draft Report on the re-evaluation of the restrictions on DINP and DIDP in toys and childcare articles which can be placed in the mouth. While RAC "concluded that a risk from mouthing of toys and childcare articles with DINP and DIDP could not be excluded if the existing restrictions on these articles were lifted", it "did not identify further uses that would cause a risk". >> Read More

ICCA Comments on WHO/UNEP Endocrine Disrupting Chemicals Report

The International Council of Chemical Associations (ICCA), of which Cefic is a member, issued a statement in response to the report published on 20 February by the World Health Organization (WHO) and the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) regarding the health effects of human exposure to certain chemicals. Cefic's Director General Hubert Mandery, who serves as Council Secretary of ICCA, commented: "The report fails to meet the standards expected for sound scientific work." >> Read More
